1. Make a list of the things your group might need money for.
  - a) Which are the most important?
  - b) Which can be left until later?
2. Choose any two ways of raising money. Talk about what you would need to do to raise money in these ways.
  - a) Will you get more money from one than the other?
  - b) Will one be more fun than the other?
3. Invite someone to your meeting who can talk about different ways of raising money.
  - a) This might be a Treasurer from another organization, or the Treasurer of a near-by self advocacy group.
4. Make a list of the things your group wants to do.
  - a) Which things can you do without money?
  - b) Which one would you need a small amount of money for?
  - c) Which ones would you need a large amount of money for?

## Things To Do in a Self Advocacy Group Meeting

The suggestion you see below may be helpful in deciding what the group will do and discuss.

- a) Draw a line down the middle of a large sheet of paper.
- b) Ask each group member what topics they would like the group to discuss.
- c) Get someone to write the list of topics down one side of the paper.
- d) Ask each member what they would like the group to do.
- e) Get someone to list these activities in the other column of the paper.
- f) At each meeting, discuss the list and alter it or add to it if you want.
- g) Use the list to choose items for the agenda at each meeting.
